

Overview of Police Strategic Advisor Post in Ministry of Interior (Northern Emirates)

Background Information

The United Arab Emirates comprises of seven emirates. Each with its own identity. Working in the UAE is interesting and challenging. It is a very safe environment. However living in a Muslim country requires a very tolerant and flexible approach. In the work environment the spoken language is Arabic and translation is frequently required, which means to be successful you will require a great deal of patience, tact and diplomacy.

Working Conditions

- The usual place of work is in UAE.
- Line management is by the Team Leader
- However you will have to attend at other locations, that may involve overnight stays and absence from your base for a few days.
- The initial contract is for a period of 2 years
- You will have a 6 months probationary period
- Normal hours of duties will be 0730 hrs to 1430 hrs. from Sunday to Thursday & Rest days Friday & Saturday
- However you may be required to attend meetings and presentations in the evenings on an average of three evenings per month.
- All national and holy (Muslim) holidays (10 days per year)
- UAE has no Tax on Incomes

Job Content:

- Being an advisor with a responsibility for the provision and continuous development for your specialist area.
- Project manage a set of action plans within your specialist area
- Developing new systems and standards of delivery.
- Enabling and facilitating the development of knowledge, understanding of modern practices
- Assisting individual officers to develop their skills.
- Giving presentations on development programmes.
- Assist with projects and other areas of policing as required
- Managing other tutors as required within your specialist field

Salary	30,000 AED's a month (Tax free)
Security Deposit	10% salary deducted every month but returned on conclusion of contract
