Access

Participants from all over the world are most likely to arrive at Incheon international airport, one of the world's busiest airport with the best convenient accessibility from any place of the world. There are several options you can choose to get to Daegu city, located at the southeastern part of Korean peninsula, from Incheon international airport area, about 50km away from Seoul. Incheon international airport is 335km away from Daegu city.

Plane

Daegu international airport operates domestic flights between Daegu and Seoul (Incheon international airport) about 2 times a day and it takes about 50minutes. Standard price for one-way is about 50USD on Apr, 2009 now.

Train

High-speed train(KTX) enables a Seoul-Daegu trip in one hour and 40 minutes with standard price of 35USD. Additional transfer will be needed to get to Seoul station for using KTX.

Limousine Bus

The first class Limousine bus with wide 3 rows seats will take you from Incheon international airport to various downtown places of Daegu in 4hours. It operates 24hours a day on 20-40 minutes intervals with the standard price of 30USD.

Please note that information above including standard price is estimated and could be changed any time. Also, WFG2010 team is on process of designing some kind of transportation only for WFG2010 participants and relatives.

Accommodation

A variety of hotels from business hotels to five-star hotels are waiting for participants with fully-equipped facilities and promise the best services. The fare of hotel is depending but it arranges from 100USD to 200USD per night on full price, in general. However WFG2010 host team is in attempt to making an special contracting on certain hotels that game participants can use hotels on 20%-30% discounted special price. For the more economical means of accommodation, you can use motels, hostels and more.









Daegu Safety Theme Park

The Daegu Safety Theme Park provides various information and knowledge regarding factors causing disasters and accidents.

It was developed from the lessons learned during the Daegu Subway Fire Disaster on February 18, 2003. We will take up the rote of 'The Mecca of Safety' for establishing a new standard of urban safety. It is a facility where you can actually experience disasters made up of state-of-the-art 4D systems such as the Subway Safety Pavilion, the Living Safety Pavilion and the Future Disaster Prevention Pavilion.

The World Championships in Athletics, one of the three major international sporting events along with Summer Olympics and World Cup, will be held for 9 days from August 27 to September 4, 2011 in Daegu Korea. The scale of participation is around 7,000 people from 212 nations (athletes and officials 3,500, Press corps: 3,500) and the categories are 46 events. (24 for men, 22 for women, excluding two events for disabled people)
