Access

Participants from all over the world are most likely to arrive at Incheon International Airport, one of the world s busiest airport with the best convenient accessibility from any place of the world. There are several options you can choose to get to Daegu (located at the southeastern part of Korea) from Incheon International Airport area, about 50km away from Seoul. Incheon International Airport is 335km away from Daegu city.

• Plane

Daegu International Airport operates domestic flights between Daegu and Seoul (Incheon International Airport) about 2 times a day and it takes about 50minutes. Standard price will be 55 USD as of Apr. 2009.

• Train

High-speed train (KTX) enables a Seoul-Daegu trip in 1 hour and 40 minutes with a standard price of 40USD. An additional transfer will be needed to get to Seoul Station for using KTX.

Please note that information above including standard price is estimated and could be changed anytime. Also, the WFG2010 team is in the process of arranging transportation for WFG2010 participating athletes and their families.

Accommodation

A variety of hotels from business hotels to five-star hotels are waiting for participants with fullyequipped facilities and promising the best services. The average hotel price ranges between 100USD to 250USD per night. However WFG2010 host team is currently in negotiations with certain hotels regarding discounts available for athletic participants.
